
#### APAC INTERNET USE

ASIA Domain Create Average: 26ms







# Anti-Abuse Highlight

• In 2015, there are 10,110 domains confirmed

- Spam: 10057

Malware: 0 (WOW!)

- Phishing: 50

Botnet C&C: 2

Fraud: 1

- Significant spam cases dropped, with effort from .ASIA Security Team, .ASIA, and .ASIA registrars
- But sophisticated attack utilizing .ASIA domains remains or increases

# Anti-Abuse Highlight

#### .ASIA Spamhaus Ranking

- In the beginning of 2014, .ASIA ranks 20<sup>th</sup>
- In mid 2014, during the promotion, .ASIA rank rises to 13<sup>th</sup> at peak
- By end of 2014, .ASIA ranks 30<sup>th</sup>
- In Jan 2015, .ASIA drops to 32<sup>nd</sup>
- In Dec 2015, .ASIA drops to 65<sup>th</sup>

## Security Enhancement

- We always make sure .ASIA systems and users running in secure manner
- In 2015, we upgrade the VPN for .ASIA's users connecting to Afilias which provides higher flexibility
- We also upgrade the digital certificate (commonly known as SSL) for connections between registrars and registry system
  - Enabling new hashing algorithm SHA-2
  - Use Industry recommended encryption: Cipher upgrade

# AWIP Compliance

- We always make sure .ASIA is compliance when ICANN introduces new policy.
- ICANN announced WHOIS Additional Information Policy (AWIP) in late 2014.
- ICANN mandated all registry must implement AWIP by Jan 31, 2016
- ASIA is AWIP compliance since February 10, 2015

- Registry Excellence continue to beat SLA
- DNS 100% uptime despite continuous attack, no interruption to end user
- Anti-abuse: Drive abuse out with active monitoring and daily intervention
- Security: Constantly enhance system and user environment
- Partnership: sharing the cost of promotions to drive growth as we had in the past
- We are providing new hosting environment to .ASIA that has higher capacity, more flexibility, and more secure (Already started)

- DotAsia Foundation (DF) is the charity arm of DotAsia Organisation (DO)
- For the fiscal year, separate accounts are prepared for DF to account for costs attributable to community
- DO inject funds into DF to fund its operation and to cover any deficit
- Staff costs and office expenses attributable to community projects are allocated/billed from DO to DF

## **Investment Portfolio (Current)**

- Investment Portfolio at JP Morgan
- Total Assets: USD3,879,667
- Total Net Asset (incl. loan): USD 579,691
- Conservative portfolio aiming at long-term investment
- Invests in a balanced fashion with focus in fixed income funds and a healthy allocation in conservative equity and balanced funds, in order to generate return via both income and capital appreciation with controlled volatility



## **Credit Facility with JPM**

## **Investment Portfolio (Current)**

- Significant drop in portfolio value due to recent market crash
- Total Wealth Loss since Jan 1, 2014 (~26 months): \$153,834 (21%)

## **Investment Portfolio (Current)**

#### JPM Comment:

- believe the majority of portfolio decline is due to temporary dislocation in the global equity markets, exacerbated by leverage
- believe the dislocation is not here to stay as the current market does not reflect the US and Europe economies
- expect a market rebound between now and mid-2016
- but not outright bullish on equity markets this year, and continue to prefer sizeable allocation in highquality fixed income assets





- In the case where no candidate is nominated from one (or both) of these Sub-Regions by the close of the nomination period, the Board shall make a suggestion of an individual satisfying the Geographical Diversity Requirement to Sponsor Members for their consideration. Thereupon, and before the close of the voting period, an eligible Sponsor Member should propose and another eligible Sponsor Member should second the nomination for a candidate who must also accept such nomination to allow for the candidate to be officially accepted.


